

# Tender Shoots Garden Club Network - Benefits

TS is national collective of UK garden clubs formed during covid so clubs could work together, have joint online events, share tips & advice, share discounts, plus much more. We have a program of gardening talks & events during the autumn winter months via Zoom. Individuals and clubs are very welcome to join in.

## Benefits for individuals & affiliated clubs:

- Access to all TS zoom talks & restricted members zoom talks

- Access to the new maps feature to help find gardens around the country

- Monthly networking meetings with clubs from around the UK to share info, tips & advice
- You can recruit more members into your club by using TS as an add on benefit for members
- Hybrid zoom meetings for your in person venues helping you to save on fees
- Use of the TS zoom account for your own club committee meetings (additionally Indy can be available if requested for consultation, help or advice)
- Periodic F2F networking meeting for club reps usually including a trip to a garden
- Networking WhatsApp group so clubs can network, ask advice, share tips etc.

There are a few additional benefits just for the committees of affiliated clubs, for example, access to extra zoom talks via our intersociety affiliations, please see the details on the Private Affiliated Clubs Area.

There are 2 membership options for joining TS:

- 1) Become an Individual Member for only £20 annually.
- 2) Your club could become Affiliated with Tender Shoots.

For clubs considering affiliation there is a small membership contribution of £25 (to help with the cost of running TS) and we ask each club to contribute a zoom talk towards our programme of zoom events (arranged either by your club or by TS). This then covers all the members of your club. If you're club already has a zoom talk on your program, then it's even easier, as that can simply be integrated through TS as your contribution and makes your own job easier because the technical aspect of zoom hosting is then managed by TS. TS works by each of the affiliated clubs collaborating and contributing to the program of events. Please get in touch if you would like to find out more and consider becoming affiliated. Or come along to one of monthly networking zoom meetings (everyone is welcome to attend), first Wednesday of each month at 7.30pm (Sep to Apr). Don't worry if you've not arranged a zoom talk before, we can help with that.

If you do join TS as an affiliated club, it's highly recommended that you book Indy for an in person face to face talk in your venue to ensure your members get the most out of TS. This would be an interactive workshop where your members will bring in their devices and Indy will walk through live on screen to help guide your members, plus learn a few gardening technology tips at the same time.

## Maps for visiting gardens

We all love visiting gardens, however with all the various society memberships we have, it can be a little cumbersome trying to figure out whether you can use the RHS partner garden membership, Gardener's World magazine 241, National Trust membership, Historic Houses membership, etc. On top of that, even if you're using your RHS membership, some gardens allow entry anytime, whereas others offer entry only during restricted times. Ordinarily you have to either read through the handbooks, or go to every website and click through to the information to figure it out. So we've created some maps to make your life easier, you can visit the maps page of our website to access all these maps. They are based on the Google Maps app so if you have a mobile phone or a tablet, these maps will integrate automatically with your device. The below diagrams show a few examples, including a map highlighting which gardens allow entry with dogs.

**BBC Gardeners' World Magazine 2-for-1 Gardens entry** – This map shows you easily which gardens have 2-for-1 entry. If you are a single visitor, then [Here is a separate link if you just want to see the BBC GW gardens that offer single person discounts](#)



RHS Partner Gardens membership grants you free access to approx 220 gardens around the world. Some have restricted access on certain days, others allow access at anytime. These 2 maps shows you easily all the places which gardens can be visited, the purple dots map shows gardens that will allow you free **ENTRY ANYTIME**, the brown dot map is **RESTRICTED ENTRY** gardens.



**Dogs allowed** – This map shows you the gardens that allow entry with dogs (most request they are on a short lead).



Other maps available include, Plant Fairs, Historic House Association Gardens, Independent Nurseries. We'll be adding more maps over time.
